Grants.gov	<p>A federal resource that offers information on over 1,000 grant programs and provides access to approximately \$500 billion in annual awards. HealthCare.gov	<p>A federal resource that provides access to health care information in light of the Affordable Care Act. National Clearinghouse for Alcohol and Drug Information	<p>A federal clearinghouse of alcohol and other drug-related information, materials, publications and resources available to community members and practitioners. Most materials are available for free and may be downloaded immediately. Other materials may be ordered in bulk for distribution to clients. National Mental Health Information Center (NMHIC)	<p>A federal resource for mental health services. Activities are centered on its website, which includes an online store, as well as a Call Center. It has more than 600 publications available, including mental health “evidence-based practice KITs.” The website also has sections organized by key topics (consumer/survivor, homelessness, suicide prevention, children’s mental health, etc.).
