

ALUMNI SURVEY

August 30, 2003 through May 2009

The University of Nevada, Reno conducted a telephone survey of its recent alumni. August 2000, December 2000, and May 2001 alumni were in the initial cohort surveyed during the spring and summer of 2002. This initial cohort of graduates will be contact again in 2004 and 2006. Subsequent cohorts of graduates will be surveyed approximately 1-year following their commencement date.

The instrument includes the 5 sections listed below. The telephone survey format permitted the interviewer to branch at given items based upon respondent's input.

Section A confirms that the person is the alumnus in question and permission to conduct the survey.

Section B asks post graduation employment status items.

Section C asks about educational programs completed, enrolled in, or plans to enroll post graduation.

Section D asks for feedback regarding the impact or contribution to a range of Core Curriculum objectives.

Section E contains 5 generic items related to the alumni's academic program. This section also includes program-specific items developed by academic programs.

Section G asks permission and specific contact information of each alumnus to contact their immediate supervisor.
