Title: **It's Your Choice: On being 18-29 and living in the United States today**

Our country is currently undergoing a transformation. The recession has drastically changed the economic landscape. Our political scene has been shaken up by the election of President Obama. Our values as a country are shifting. However, for us between the ages of 18 and 29, this is also a time of personal transformation. In this class we will explore many national issues, focusing on how they affect young people and how we can influence those issues. We will also be discussing the educational, career, personal, and interpersonal decisions that people our age make. What are our options? How are our options different than the options earlier generations had? What influence do national happenings have on our options? And how does anyone make the big decisions we are faced with? Our buzzwords for this class are choice (it's not what you think it is), consumerism (beyond Apple, Disney, and Starbucks), and citizenship (not the 12th grade government class definition of the word; we will talk about being a social individual in a larger, organized system). We will investigate these issues through a variety of texts: magazine articles, televised talks, film, and other sources. Several guests will be invited in to be interviewed by the class about their lives and choices. As part of the goal of this class is to introduce you to collegiate research, you will also be finding some of your own readings for class. Throughout the semester, we will work to improve your writing and reading chops. This is an intensive 16-week course in reading, writing, revising, and researching; several hours per week outside of class reading, writing, revising, and researching are expected and necessary to pass this class.
