Introduction Description:



Sometimes computers just seem to quit working properly. Often some simple maintenance will get a computer up and running again. Other times it is easier to simply re-format a computer and start over. This training will cover these topics. We will work on Dell Dimension 4400's, but information and skills obtained from this training will apply to many different computers out there. We will reformat the hard drives and reinstall Windows XP, drivers, service pack 2, and several pieces of software. Then we will perform basic maintenance on the computers such as; setting up the network connection, changing the computer name, and changing other computer settings. I am Planning on meeting several times for two hours each beginning October 6. We will Meet for 2 hours each night on Wed and Thursdays.
