

CURRENT (page 9 of the constitution)

The Nominations and Elections Committee shall:

1. Solicit recommendations for nominations from the entire membership in a timely manner;
2. Nominate at least two candidates for each office;

In the event that two viable candidates cannot be found for the ballot, the Nominations and Elections Committee will present the name of the one candidate to the Executive Board for approval to run one candidate, unopposed. It is expected that every effort will be made by the Nominations and Elections Committee to secure two candidates for each office;

Other nominations may be made by any group of ten (10) active members who sign a nominations petition;

3. Nominations sent to all active members at least six (6) weeks prior to the annual business meeting shall be voted upon by mail and returned to the designated CEC contact no later than two (2) weeks prior to the annual business meeting.

E. The Constitution and Bylaws Committee shall:

1. Revise or update portions of the constitution and bylaws as needed;
2. Develop, revise or update policies and procedures to accompany the constitution and bylaws;
3. Submit reports to the Executive Board giving reasons for proposed changes;
4. Make the report of the suggested changes approved by the Executive Board available to the membership, using the newsletter and the website as the vehicles for informing the membership, and giving the membership notice as to when action will be taken on the suggested revisions.
5. Submit the revised Constitution and Bylaws to CEC.
