CAMP DIRECTOR

Dr. Andrew Heglund is an associate professor at the University of Nevada, Reno, where he teaches percussion, directs the University Percussion Ensemble and coaches jazz small groups. He earned a doctor of arts degree in music from the University of Northern Colorado and a master of music degree in jazz studies from the University of North Texas. Dr. Heglund performs with faculty jazz quintet The Collective, with Christin Schillinger in a bassoon/percussion duo, and with the Ed Corey Trio, Reno Jazz Orchestra and Reno Philharmonic Discover Music Percussion Ensemble. Also a composer, he has had several solo percussion works choreographed and performed with the Sierra Nevada Ballet.

SYMPHONIC BAND

Douglas Akey has been director of bands and chair of the music/drama department at Hendrix Junior High School in Chandler, Ariz., since 1987, and has taught junior high school band for more than 30 years. He earned a bachelor of music degree in instrumental music and a master of music degree in solo performance from Arizona State University. In 1985, he received the Stanbury Award of the American School Band Directors Association as the outstanding young junior high school band director in the United States. In 1996, he was honored as the National Federation of Secondary Schools Music Educator of the Year.

CAMP GUIDELINES

All campers are required to adhere to camp rules and expected to participate in all camp activities. Failure to follow rules and meet participation expectations may result in dismissal from camp without a refund of camp fees. **Please note:** Lake Tahoe Music Camp provides percussion instruments *only*. MEDICAL CONSIDERATIONS

Camp staff have received first-aid training. However, there are no professionally trained medical personnel at camp. In the event of an emergency, campers will be taken to the nearest urgent care facility or hospital emergency room. Prior to camp, parents or guardians are required to complete the Identification and Emergency Information Form. At registration, campers and parents/guardians must meet with the assistant camp director to review this form and to discuss any medications and/or health conditions that may affect the camper's experience.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Mike Smukal is the band director at Charles A. Silvestri Junior High School in Las Vegas. He earned a master's degree in music education from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. Smukal is past state president of the International Association of Jazz Educators and has published several jazz arrangements through Creative Jazz Composers. Among other accomplishments, Smukal toured with Elvis Presley for two years, performed as a member of the house bands at the Desert Inn and Caesar's Palace, and served as assistant conductor at the Tropicana.

CONCERT BAND

Jose Flores has been teaching in the Washoe County School District for 14 years, and started the only public school mariachi program in northern Nevada. He has won a distinguished performance award from the Washoe County Teachers Association, and teacher of the year awards from KRN News Channel 4, Northern Nevada Medical Center, Sierra Schools Credit Union and the U.S. Senate. He was also selected as a teacher fellow by the National Symphony Orchestra at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts. Active as a saxophone instructor and festival adjudicator, he holds bachelor's and master's degrees in music education from the University of Nevada, Reno.
