

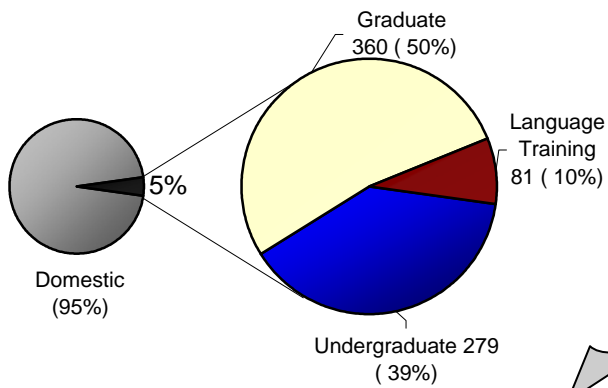

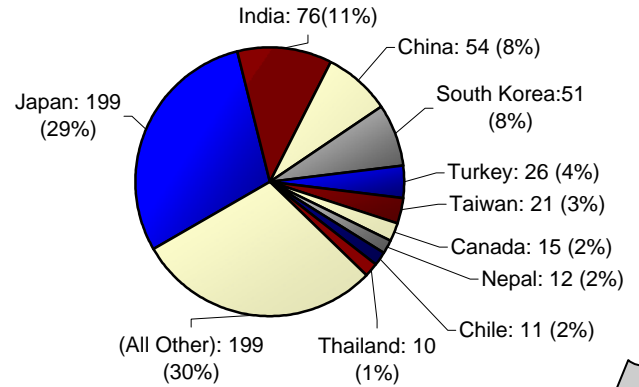

DISTRIBUTION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



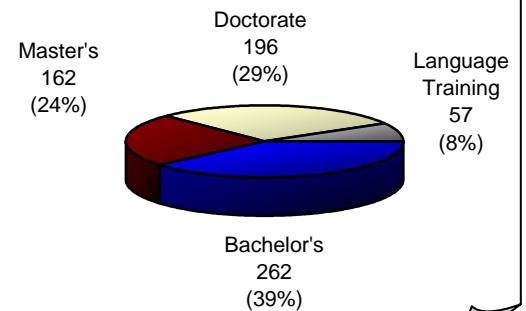
