To apply to the University of Nevada, Reno (UNR) international students should do the following:

WEB 09

- Submit a completed International Student Application.
- Submit \$95 non-refundable application fee. The fee can be paid by check, international postal order, money order, or cashier's check payable to the "Board of Regents." The fee cannot be waived and must be received before an application can be processed. To pay by credit card, complete the application fee section or apply on-line at: <http://www.ss.unr.edu/apply/>.
- Submit the official Test Of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) academic score. TOEFL scores need to be sent directly from the Educational Testing Service (ETS). Please indicate institution code 4844 and department code 00 to ensure that the scores are sent to the University of Nevada, Reno.
- Submit a signed Financial Data Form accompanied by original bank statement verifying a minimum of \$28,300 U.S. for the Fall 2009 or Spring 2010 semesters. Financial documents must be dated within the previous 12 months of application submission and may come from any dependable source, including scholarships, personal funds, or funds from the student's family. Financial documentation should be on bank letterhead. Financial documents must be received before an I-20 form can be issued.
- Students transferring to UNR from another school within the U.S. need to submit a completed Transfer Verification Form which can be downloaded from <http://www.unr.edu/oiss/forms/request%20forms.htm#transfer>.
- Submit a copy of the passport biographical page. Students transferring from other schools, need to submit copies of previous I-20(s) or DS-2019(s), visa(s), and I-94 card.
- Request original transcripts to be sent directly from the high school and/or higher educational institution(s) attended, along with official English translations. Official transcripts must arrive at UNR in envelopes sealed by the institution(s) and contain proper original signatures, stamps, and institution seal(s). Copies of transcripts will not be accepted as they are considered unofficial.

Undergraduate degree (Bachelor's) seeking students should also submit:

- Official high school transcripts showing graduation date and/or certificate of graduation and official transcripts from any higher education institutions attended. The undergraduate application, transcripts, financial documents, and test scores must be addressed to:

Graduate degree (Master's, Doctorate) seeking students should also submit:

- Official Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) scores sent directly from ETS to UNR, institution code 4844, if it is required by your department.
- Contact your academic department to inquire about any additional documents such as a written statement of purpose, letters of recommendation, and/or test scores that may be required. If required, these documents need to be sent directly to the intended graduate program. If you are seeking a graduate assistantship, teaching or research, you should contact your academic department directly. The academic departments make decisions on awarding assistantships.
