The Pennington Student Achievement Center is a 78,000 square-foot building that opened in February 2016. It is centrally located on campus and brings together a variety of student services in order to better serve our faculty and student population.

Pennington Student Achievement Center not only offers a myriad of student services, but it also offers 2 smart classrooms, a meditation and reflection room, student collaboration rooms, social stairs and a deli which serves local food and coffee.

As an Intern with Counseling Services you will have your own private office to facilitate individual counseling, group counseling, assessment, consultation, outreach, and providing supervision. Each office is equipped with beautiful furnishings that coordinate with the building including session chairs and modern office décor that creates a welcoming and professional environment.



The University of Nevada, Reno is one of eight institutions of higher education governed by the Nevada System of Higher Education. With a growing student enrollment in the Fall of 2015 approaching 21,000, 35% of our student body are from traditionally underrepresented populations. The Fall 2015 freshmen class also had the highest GPA and the highest test scores of any new incoming class enrolled, while also being comprised of 42% of underrepresented ethnic groups. With a total budget of nearly \$527 million and research awards of just over \$196 million, the university provides a comprehensive selection of degree programs at the undergraduate, graduate and doctoral levels. Recently recognized as an emerging Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), the university is also recognized as a “Top Tier” Best National University by U.S. News & World Report (6th year in a row). The university is located in the picturesque Truckee Meadows at the base of the Sierra Nevada and in the middle of the nation’s next new College Town, the City of Reno. The University of Nevada, Reno is just a short distance from the state capitol, the beautiful Lake Tahoe area, numerous state and national parks. Also, the City of Reno is less than a 4 hours’ drive from San Francisco.
