

ADVISING TAKEAWAYS

• Take IS 201 while taking the Pre-Bus Core

- IS 201 is NOT pre-requisite to IS 301
- Upper division IS courses are typically not offered during the Summer
- Econ 305 is usually offered only during the Fall semester.
- All ACC courses that are prerequisites to other ACC courses require a grade of C or better. You can only attempt an upper division accounting course twice, if you do not get a C or better on either attempt, you must change your major.
