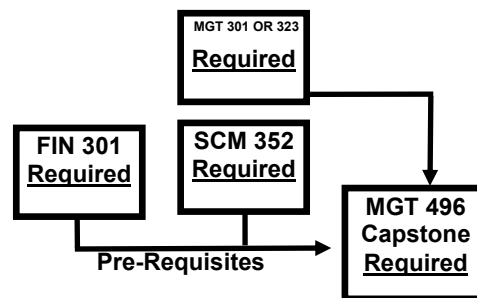

- Prerequisites: ENG 102; CH 201 or CH 202 or CH 203 or CH 212, MGT 301 OR 323, FIN 301, SCM 352

### Graduation Requirements

120+ credits earned to meet Bachelor's degree requirements  
2.0+ UNR, Cumulative, Major, AND Minor GPAs  
30+ upper-division credits earned at UNR  
40+ upper-division credits required for degree

### Applying for Graduation

Eligible students **must** submit graduation applications in MyNEVADA by:

- March 1st for Spring graduation (application opens November 1st)
- June 1st for Summer graduation (application opens March 21<sup>st</sup>)
- October 1st for Fall graduation (application opens April 1st)
