# Accelerated Bachelor's/Master's Program Application

An accelerated bachelor's/master's program allows outstanding University of Nevada, Reno students to obtain both a baccalaureate and a master's degree in an accelerated timeframe. To apply you must have completed at least 75 credits toward the bachelor's degree with a 3.0 UNR GPA, typically during the spring of the junior year. It is best to apply one month in advance of the opening of course registration (by October 1 for the following spring semester and by March 1 for the following fall semester). Contact the department offering the graduate component of the accelerated program for a list of the specific undergraduate courses that must be completed prior to submission of this application and later to submit the completed application. The department will forward the application to the Graduate School for successful applicants. As part of the admission process, students must select a faculty advisor for their program.
