ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following items are required for admission:

1. A completed **Application for Admission** dated and signed and any other required department signatures (see below).
2. **Application Fee:** a non-refundable \$60 application see if required for all applicants. This must be paid at the Cashier's Office.
3. **Immunizations:** Official documentation for two doses for measles, mumps rubella (MMR) and a diphtheria/tetanus (DT) shot within the last ten years. If you were born prior to 1957, documentations of an MMR is not required. If documentation is not received, a registration hold may be placed on your records.
4. **Residency status:** Individuals eligible for in-state resident fees are required to submit an application for resident fees.

Undergraduate Nondegree: An individual who is not admitted to a degree program is defined as a nondegree student. Individuals who have earned a bachelor's degree and are returning solely for the purpose of obtaining an undergraduate certificate/licensure/minor may apply as a nondegree. All other individuals who have earned a baccalaureate are recommended to apply for graduate special status. A nondegree student may register for a maximum of 8 undergraduate semester credits per semester and may not enroll in graduate-level classes. Although there is no limit to the number of credits that may be earned as a nondegree student, a maximum of 32 semester credits is acceptable toward a baccalaureate degree. Nondegree students are not eligible for financial aid, including student loans.

Graduate Special: The graduate special classification is for students who have earned a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution and who wish to take graduate courses but do not plan to pursue a program leading to an advanced degree or for applicants who do not meet the requirements for admission to regular graduate standing. Admission to graduate special status does not constitute admission to the Graduate School. With graduate special classification, a student may enroll for undergraduate or graduate credit and may satisfy the teacher certificate requirements. Although there is no limit to the number of credits that may be earned as a graduate special student, a maximum of 9 semester credits may be applied toward a program of study. Graduate special students are not eligible for financial aid, including student loans.
