College of Engineering Accelerated Bachelor's/ Master's Program

Request permission to register for College of Engineering graduate classes. This is NOT an application for admission to the graduate degree.

An accelerated bachelor's/master's program allows outstanding University of Nevada, Reno students to obtain both a baccalaureate and a master's degree in an accelerated time frame. To be eligible you must have completed at least 75 credits toward the bachelor's degree with a 3.2 UNR GPA, which typically occurs at the end of the junior year.

During the student's senior year, students will apply for admission to the Graduate School. Students must meet all Graduate School and departmental requirements for admission. This may include a GPA and/or GRE requirement. As part of the admission process, students must select a faculty advisor for their program. **Students are not eligible to be admitted to the graduate program until they complete their undergraduate program.**
