Graduate Teaching Assistantship Application 2019

A Graduate Teaching Assistantship position in the Art Department is a 10 hour/week part-time position (0.5 position). Working more than 20 hours is not permitted by the Graduate School as well as by the department. If you find another GTA position and/or work-study outside the department, you must notify the Graduate Director.

GTA-ship positions in the department are given through this competitive process. The decision will be made by the faculty member based on the following:

- Quality of application materials
- Productivity of student's studio work
- Participation in departmental events (artist talks, studio visit, receptions, etc.)
- Student's technical skill
- Level of students' responsibility, leadership, organization skill, etc.
- Financial needs (University Scholarship application and FAFSA)
- Previous year's GTA work

For the incoming students, the application materials for the program are considered to be the application for GTA-ship.

Email the following required materials to the Graduate Director by **March 15 at 11:59 pm**. Late submissions will not be considered for the position.

- Specialized and/or Private Training
- Teaching Experience / Employment (Name & School/ Agency, Title/ Rank, Part-time/Full-time, No. of months)
- Publications and/or memberships in professional organizations
- Exhibitions (date, exhibition title, locale, one person/group/curated/juried, media)

3. Statement of interest

Please write a one-page statement of interest to explain your interest in teaching, the area(s) of greatest instructional interest, and your area(s) of greatest experience.

4. Teaching philosophy
Please write a one-page teaching philosophy.
5. Artist's Statement
6. Image inventory
Please include your name, title, media, dimensions, and date completed. It may include brief descriptions where necessary.
7. Portfolio
Provide 10-15 images of your works. For time-based media, prepare a 3-5 minute highlight reel and provide a website link to the reel. Your artwork must have been created within the last two years.
