By completing this form, you agree to comply with the University Parking Rules and Regulations and assume financial responsibility for any fees assessed against any vehicle you operate on campus. The Parking and Transportation Services Department is not responsible for vehicle or property theft, vehicle damage or vandalism incurred on campus. Parking permits are not transferrable between individuals and cannot be re-sold. If you are in possession of a permit that you did not purchase from the Parking and Transportation Services Department, or if your permit is altered, fines in excess of \$500 will be issued.

On-campus resident parking options (students and employees)

To purchase a permit, please select from the available permit options below. Only one permit per person allowed per academic term. The only exception is a motorcycle/moped and bicycle permit may also be purchased. Parking permits are non-transferable and may not be duplicated. Those no longer living on campus may be eligible for a pro-rated refund or exchange. No overnight parking allowed in commuter parking zones. Overnight parking is only allowed in the designated area indicated on the front of the permit. Yellow zones and orange zones are available in limited quantities.
