The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant was developed by the U.S. Department of Education to encourage students interested in teaching or working in other high-need fields in schools. Recipients must work full-time in a high-need field in schools serving low-income students for at least four school years within 8 years of completing, or otherwise ceasing to be enrolled in the program for which you received a TEACH Grant at the University.

- Pre-majors and non-degree programs are NOT eligible

If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award, or if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.
